Canada Emergency Response Benefit

Additionally, we have provided a link to the Government of Canada's Emergency Response Benefit to help workers and businesses. This **taxable benefit** would provide **\$2,000** a month for up to four months for workers who lose their income as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Workers who are still employed, but are not receiving income because of disruptions to their work situation due to COVID-19, would also qualify for the CERB. This would help businesses keep their employees as they navigate these difficulty times, while ensuring they preserve the ability to quickly resume operations as soon as it becomes possible.
